Indonesian Scholar Journal (ISJ) is looking for Indonesian academic/scientist with strong leadership quality, passion for research, and desire to improve Indonesia's research and publication quality to hold position as Chief Executive Officer (CEO). The overall task of the CEO is to lead ISJ to become an indexed and respected International Journal from Indonesia.

ISJ is an independent academic journal born as a result of a collaborative effort among Indonesian students associations (Perhimpunan Pelajar Indonesia – PPI) around the world. The idea was first coined in the Overseas Indonesian Students Association's plenary meeting in Malaysia on February 2012. ISJ arises as a movement to strengthen Indonesian research through an online publication of scientific journals. This journal is expected to comprehensively combine the knowledge of Indonesian academics into one scientific writing repository that can be easily accessed by anyone around the world.

ISJ consists of six different journal types, namely :

- ISJ A : Life Science
- ISJ B : Physical Science
- ISJ C : Medicine
- ISJ D : Mathematics and Engineering Science
- ISJ E : Economics, business, and Management
- ISJ F : Politics, Law, International Relation, and Public Policy

The goal of ISJ is to encourage education and research through the spirit of writing and sharing ideas and knowledge. In the long-term, ISJ is aimed to be indexed by highly reputable institutions, such as Scopus and ISI Web of Knowledge.

The CEO will work with 61 highly qualified ISJ members located in 33 cities from 15 different countries around the world. The team is currently consists of 18 Masters and 47 PhD degree holders or candidates from various academic backgrounds. Our team is divided into two divisions, namely technical (e.g., publication, public relation, and organization) and academic divisions (peer review and editorial).

The CEO position is expected to be long term and will become part of the candidate's academic career together with other ISJ team members. We are committed to foster collaborative environment, networking, and knowledge sharing culture. Finally the strategic position allows the candidate to be directly involved in improving Indonesia's academic performances, connected with tens of thousands of Indonesian students/academics worldwide, represent ISJ in Indonesia diaspora events, and as a pivot to advance his/her academic career.

- A PhD degree in any discipline.
- Minimum one year Postdoctoral experience.
- A record of high quality research as evidenced by publications in reputable international journals and conferences.
- Experience as reviewer of international journals and conferences.
- International collaboration experience on multi-field research project (outside candidate's core expertise) is a plus.
- Strong leadership quality and dedication.
- Good time management skill is crucial.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Organisational experience is a plus.
